ASSIGNMENT.

Whereas, on the second day of December, A.D. 1911, a certain contract and agreement was entered into by and between Loren Conaway, P. J. Hurley, and C. J. Wrightsman, Gypsy Oil Company, a corporation, and E. M. Arnold, declaring the respective interests and ownership in and to the oil and gas mining rights in and under the following described lands situate in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to wit:

West half of southwest quarter and northeast quarter and northeast quarter of southwest quarter of section 8, township 18 north, containing 120 acres, more or less; and,

Whereas, by said agreement, C. J. Wrightsman was recognized as owning and holding an undivided eight forty eighths ($\frac{8}{48}$) of all the oil and gas in and under said lands: and,

Whereas, said eighty forty-eighths ($\frac{8}{48}$) interest in said oil and gas lease was hereto fore assigned and transferred to the Wrightsman Oil Company, of Delaware, and thereafter said interest was assigned by the said Wrightsman Oil Company, of Delaware, to C. J. Wrightsman, and by said C. J. Wrightsman, transferred to the Wrightsman Petroleum Company a Delaware corporation, by assignment dated March 2, 1922, and thereafter the said interest was assigned by the said Wrightsman Petroleum Company to the Elk Oil Producing Company by assignment dated December 1, 1923; and

Whereas, the date of the lease attempted to be assigned, and the book and page of record thereof, is misdescribed in the assignment from said C. J. Wrightsman to the Wrightsman Petroleum Company, and also in the assignment from Wrightsman Petroleum Company, to the said Elk Oil Producing Company, and it is desired to correct such error;

Now, therefore, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned C. J. Wrightsman, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and Wrightsman Petroleum Company, a Delaware Corporation, do hereby sell, transfer, assign, set over and convey unto the said Elk Oil Producing Company, as aforesaid, in and to all the oil and gas mining rights in said land, together with all fractional interest rights in said land, together with all fractional interest in all personal property used or obtained in connection with the production of oil and gas from said land as defined by said contract of December 2, 1911, and a subsequent contract dated August 30, 1916, by and between Loren Conaway, C. J. Wrightsman, E. M. Arnold, E. S. Ross, Henry N. Greis and Gypsy Oil Company, providing for the production of casing head gasoline from the wells on said property.

And for the same consideration the undersigned, for themselves, their successors and representatives, do hereby covenant with said assignee, its successors and assigns that they are the lawful owners of said eighty forty-eighths interest in and to the oil and gas
