Unallotted Land Deed

Tulsa County.

THE MUSKOGEE (CREEK) NATION
State of Oklahoma.
Formerly Indian Territory.

To all to whom these presents shall come, greeting:

Whereas, the land hereinafter described is a portion of the unallotted lands of the Muskogee (Creek) Tribe of Indians, and the same has been sold to Edna I. Metz, for the sum of six hundred and no/100 dollars (\$600.00) in accordance with the regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior, Reg. Aug. 20, 1919, under the provisions of Section sixteen of the Act of Congress approved April 26, 1906 (34 Stat. L. 137).

Now, therefore, I, the undersigned, the Principal Chief of the Muskogee (Creek) Nation, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by law, have granted and conveyed, and by these presents do grant and convey unto the said Edna I. Metz, all right, title and interest of the Muskogee (Creek Nation) and of all of the Citizens thereof in and to the following described land, viz:

The north two and 50/100 (2.50) acres of the south five (5) acres
of the south five (5) acres of the north twenty (20) acres of lot
one (1) of section ten (10) township nineteen (19) north, and range
ten (10) east,

of the Indian Base and Meridian, in Oklahoma, containing, two and 50/100 (2.50) acres
more or less, as the case may be, according to the United States survey thereof.

In witness whereof, I, the principal Chief of the Muskogee (Creek) Nation, have
hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of said Nation to be affixed this - - -
day of May 3rd, A.D. 1920.
