Creek Nation, Oklahoma.

This indenture, of lease, made and entered into in quadruplicate on this 6th day of February, 1924, by and between Emma Childers/^{now}Chalekee, and Jimmy Chalekee, her husband, Broken Arrow, Okla., full blood citizen of the Creek Nation, Roll No. 720, party of the first part, hereinafter designated as lessor, and W. B. Pine/^{of}Chalekee, Oklahoma, party of the second part, hereinafter designated as lessee, under and in pursuance of the provision of the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908 (35 Stat. L.P. 312) witnesseth:

1. The lessor, for and in consideration of one dollar, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and of the royalties, covenants, stipulations and conditions hereinafter contained, and hereby agreed to be paid, observed and performed by the lessee, does hereby demise, grant, lease, and let unto the lessee, for the term of ten years from the date of the approval hereof by the Secretary of the Interior, and as much longer thereafter as oil or gas is found in paying quantities, all the oil deposits and natural gas in or under the following described tract of land, lying within the county of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit: The West half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) north east quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$), of section 20, township 18N, range 14E, of the Indian Meridian, and containing 120 acres, more or less, with the exclusive right to prospect for, extract, pipe, store and remove oil and natural gas, and to occupy and use so much, only of the surface of said land as may reasonable be necessary to carry on the work of prospecting for, extracting, piping, storing, and removing such oil and natural gas, also the right to obtain from wells or other sources on said lands by means of pipe lines or otherwise, a sufficient supply of water to carry on said operations, and also the right to use free of cost, oil and natural gas as fuel so far as necessary to the development and operation of said property.
