The Muskogee(Croek) Nation, formerly Indian Territory, now Oklahoma,

To all to whom these presents shall come, greeting:

Whereas, a townsite commission, heretofore appointed and acting under the authority of the Act of Congress, approved March 1, 1901 (31 Stats. 861) agreement ratified by the Creek Nation May 25, 1901, has appraised the lots in the town of Take, Muskogee (Creek) Nation, Indian Territory; and

Whereas, the put of said town was approved by the Secretary of the Interior on the 11 day of April, 1902, and was dily placed in file; and

Whereas, said commission has appraised all of the town lots included in said plat at their true value, excluding improvements, which appraisal has been approved by the Secretary of the Interior; and

Whereas, the said commission has awarded the real estate described herinbelow to Mabel Alice Perry, who has paid eight thousand one hundred fiftyAnd no/10 0 (68150.00) dollars, the full amount of the prohase price, into the treasury of the United States, to the credit of the Muskogee or Creek Nation of Indians, with the United States Indian Agent, at Muskogee, Indian Territory, and is therefore entitled to a patent;

Now, therefor I, the undersigned, the Principal Chief of the Muskogee)Cr eek)
Nation, do, by virtee of the power and authority vested in me by the aforesaid Act of
Congress, of the United States, hereby grant sell, and convey unto the said Mabel Alice
Perry, heirs and assigns foreverall the right title, and interest of the Muskogee(Creek)
Nation, aforesaid, in and to lot numbered 1 in Block numbered 36 is the tewn of 36,
in the Town of Tulsa, Muskogee (Creek) Nation, Indian Territory, and a coording to the
plat thereof on file as aforesaid.

In witness whereof, I, the Principal Chief of the Lastogee (Greek) Nation, have here unto set my hand and caused the great seal of said nation to be affixed at the date hereinafter shown.
