

first duly sworn on oath, state: That we have resided in Tulsa, Oklahoma, for more than fifteen years; that each of us are well and personally acquainted with the premises described as follows, to-wit:

Lot five(5) and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  section of twenty six (26) township twenty (20) north, range twelve (12) east, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, containing sixty nine and sixty three hundredths (69.63) acres more or less.

Winterringer, and Nellie Winterringer, his wife, platted and dedicated said above described premises, except that portion occupied by the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma and by Willis W. Winterringer, for said premises, said deed being dated May 22, 1911, and recorded in book 109, at page 50, in the office of the register of deeds for Tulsa County, Oklahoma, said premises were not occupied, claimed or resided upon by the said Daisy Hensley as her homestead, but that said premises at the time of the execution of said deed, were vacant and unoccupied.

That W. J. Hensley in O.C.D. to Willis W. Winterringer dated April 6, 1923, and filed for record April 17, 1923, and recorded in book 423, at page 368, of the records of the office of the County Clerk, and ex-officio register of deeds for Tulsa County, Oklahoma, is the husband of said Daisy Hensley; that said premises were never occupied, claimed or resided upon by said Daisy Hensley, or said W. J. Hensley, as their homestead.

Affiants further state that at the time of the execution of the first above mentioned deed by Daisy Hensley, that she and her husband, W. J. Hensley, were residents of Kern County, State of California, and at the time of the execution of the last above mentioned deed by W. J. Hensley, husband of Daisy Hensley, that they both resided in Kern County, State of California.
