Provided always, and this instrument is made and execut upon the following conditions, to-wit:

Said parties of the first part are justly indebtedn to the party of the second part, in/the principal sum of #1200,0C) twelve hundred dollars, being for a loan made by the said party of the second part to the said parties of the first part and payable according to the tenor and effect of one (1) negotiable promissory note, executed and delivered by the said parties of the first part, bearing date April 15, 1924, and rayable to the order of the said party of the second part, as follows:

One for \$1200.00 due April 15, 19247

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All payable at the orfice of Exchange National Bank, Tulsa, Okla, with interest thereon from date until maturity or default, at the rate of eight (8) per cent per annum, and at the rate of 10 per centum per annum after default or maturity, payable semi-annually, bath before and after maturity, on the 15th day of October, and April, ineach year. The installments of interest until maturity are further evidenced by 6 coupon interest notes, of even date herewith, and executed by the said parties of the first part, each bearing interest after maturity at the rate of 10 per nent perannum.

2. The said parties of the first part covenant: and agree topay all taxes and assessments, general and special, and of whatever characterr whatsoever, on the said premises, by the State of Oklahoma, or bythe county, township or municipality, wherein said ræal estate is bituated, when the same becomesdue, and to keep the buildings upon the mortgaged premises insured in some reliable fire and tornado insurance company approved by the party of the second part for the sum of \$1500.00 and to assign the policies to the said party of the second part, as her interests may appear, and deliver said policies and renewals, to said party of the second part and to be held by her until this mortgage is fully paid, and said parties of the first part assumes all responsibility of proof and care and expense of collecting such insuance if loss soccurs.

3. The parties of the first partgree to keep all buildings, fences and other imare provements ondsaid premises in as good repair as they/now, and notto allow or commit any waste on said premises and to permit any of the improvements to be recovered therefrom or to become delapidated or destroyed.

4. It is furtherexpressly agreed by and between the parties hereto that if any default be made in the payment of any part of either said principal or interest notes: when the same becomes due, or in case of default, in the payment of any installment of taxes, or assessments, upon said premises, or the premiums of said fire and tornado, when the same becomes due, or in case of removal of any of the buildings or other improvements
