ORDINANCE NO. 2591.

An ordinance adding and annexing to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, a certain tract of land within Tulsa County, Oklahoma, described as follows, to-wit: A part of lot seven (7) in section eleven (11) township nineteen (19) north, range twelve (12) east, In Tulsa County, Oklahoma, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point 771 feet south of the quarter section corner between sections 11 and 12, township 19, north, range 12 east; thence south 74 degrees west a distance of 345.5 feet; thence southeasterly along a curve with a radius of 8,584 feet a distance of 460 feet to the section line between sections 11 and 12, thence north along said section line a distance of 444.4 feet, more or less, to place of beginning, and declaring an emergency.

Whereas, it has been made to appear to the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, that the hereinafter described tract of land, situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, lies contiguous to and adjoins the corporate limits of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, on three or more sides.
