and should be annexed to the City of Tulsa and entered within its corporate limits and that said tract of land does not exceed forty (40) acres.

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma,

Section 1, That a tract of land abutting on three sides with the corporate limits of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, more particularly COMPARIN described as follows, to-wit

A part of lot seven (7) in section eleven (11) township nineteen(19) north, range twelve (12) east, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point 771 feet southof the quarter section corner between sections 11 and 12, township 13 north, range 12 east, thence south 74 degrees west a distance of 345.5vfeet; thence southeasterly along a curve with a radius of 8,594 feet a disance of 460 feet, to the section line between sections 11 and 12; thence north along sid section line a distance of 444.4 feet, more or less to theplace of beginning, be and the same is hereby added to and annexed to the said City of Alsa, Oklahoma, and the corporate limits of said city be and same hereby are extended to include said tract of land for all puroses.

Section2, That the City of Tulsa, Okahoma, hereby retains and reserves a perpetaul easement and right to enter upon and use only purtion of the above described tract of land and to build, condtruct, lay, maintain, alter or repair any sewer lines, water lines, gas lines, telephone lines, telegraph lines, electric lines or any other public utilities.

Section 3, That from and after this ordinance takes effect the real estate described in section 1. hereof, shall be a part of the Cityof Tusa, Oklahoma, and all persons residing therein and all property situated thereon, shall be and archereby declated to be subject in all respect to and pariculars to the juris diction, control and laws and ordinances of said city of Tulsa, Oklahoma,

Section 4. That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.

Passed and the emergency clause ruled upin seperately and approved this 12th day of February, 1924.
