This indenture of lease, made and interedin quadruplicate on this 7th day of June, A.D. 1920, by and between Esther Rabey (nee) Bruner, Tulsa, Oklahoma, of enrolled as full-blood citizen of the Creek Nation, Roll No. 9514, pary of the first part, hereinafter designated as lessor and V. A. Schiefelbusch, and P. W. Sharp, half interest each, of Sand Springs, Oklahoma, party of the second part, hereinafter designated as lessee under and in pursuance of the provisims of the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908 (35 Stat. L.P.312) Witnesseth:

1- The lessor, for and in consideration of one dollar, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, and of the royalties, covenants, stipulations, and conditions hereinafter contained, and hereby agreed to be paid, observed and performed by the lessee.does hereby demise, grant, lease, and let unto the lessee for the term of ten years from the date of the approval hereof by the Secretary of the Interior, and as much longer thereafter as oil or gas is found in paying quantities all the oil deposits and natural gas in or under the following described tract of land, lying and being within and county of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: The east half of the southwest quarter, and lots six (6) and seven (7), of section 6, township 19 N, range 12 E, of the Ind-Meridian, and containing 164.97 acres, more or less, with the exclusive right to prospect for, extract pipe, store, and remove ail and natural gas, and to occupy and use so much, only of the surface of said land as may reasonably be necessary to carryon the work of prospecting for, extracting, piping, storing and removing such oil and natural gas, also the right to obtain from wells or other sources on said land by means of pipe lines or ctherwise, a sufficient supply of water to carry on said operations, and also the right to use, free of cost, oil and natural gas as fuel so far as necessary to the development and operation of said property.

2. The lessee hereby agrees to pay or cause to be paid to the Superintendent for the Five Civilized Tribes, Muskógee, Oklahoma, for thelessor, as royalty, the sum of/12-5 per cent of the gboss proceeds of all crude oil extrated from the said land, such payment to be made at the time of sale or removal of the oil. And the lesses shall pay as royalty on each gas producing well three hundred dollars per amum in advance, to be calculated from the date of commencement of utilization: Provided, however, in the case of gas wells of small volume, when the rock pressure is one hundred pounds or less, the parties hereto may, subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior agree upon a royalty, which will become effective as a part of this leas; Provided, further, that in case of gas wells of small volume, or where the wells produce both oil and gas or oil and gas and salt water to such extent that the gas is unfit for ordinarydomestic purposes, or where the gas from any well is desired for temporary use in connection with drilling and pumping operations onadjacent or nearby tracts, the lessee shall have the option of paying royalties upon such gas wells of the same purcentage of the gross proceeds from the sale of gas from such wells as is raid under
