WARRANTY DEED.
Special.

This indenture, made and entered into this 13th day of January, 1915, between Charles Page of Tulsa, Oklahoma, of the first part, and hereinafter designated the seller, and D. Blaypool of the second part, hereinafter designated the purchaser,

Witnesseth: That whereas, Charles Page is the founder of the Sand Springs Home, located in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, and in the vicinity of the lands hereinafter described and proposes to incorporate the same as a charitable organization under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, and

Now, for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and no 100 dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and also of the further consideration of the agreement between the parties hereto, for themselves, their heirs, successors and legal representatives, that intoxicating liquors shall never be manufactured, sold or otherwise disposed of, as a beverage, in any place of public resort, in and upon the premises hereby granted or any part thereof and the express reservation to the seller, his heirs, and assigns, that in case that any of the conditions concerning intoxicating liquors are broken by the purchaser, his heirs, successors, assigns or legal representatives, that this deed shall become null and void, and all right, title and interest in and to the premises hereby conveyed, shall revert to the said Sand Springs Home, a corporation to be formed as aforesaid, its successors and assigns, and the purchaser, by
