- 3. That the gantee shall have the right at any time to change the size of its line of pipe.
- 4. That the grantee shall pay all damage to fences, crops and premises, which my be suffored by reason of laying, maintenance, operation or alteration of said lines of pipe. If not mutually agred upon, said damages are to be ascertained and determined by three disinterested persons, one thereof to be appointed by the owner of the premises, one by the grantee, and the third by the two so appointed as aforesaid, and the award of two of such three persons shall be final and conclusive.

This contract shall bind and run in favor of the aspective parties hereto, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns.

Said line to be laid and constructed not to exceed thirty five (35) feet from center of public highway on east side of public high way on east side of above described premises and with privileges of ingress and egress not to exceed forty (40) feet from center of said highway.
