WITNESSETH:

That the said party of the first part has mortgaged and hereby mortgages to the said second party, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate and premises situated in the County of Tulsa State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

All of lot number fifteen (15) and the east fifty feet of lot number fourteen (14) in block number fifty eight (58) in the city of Collinsville in Tulsa County, Oklahoma;
