DECREE.

This cause coming on to be heard this 12th day of January, 1924, before me, Z.I. J.Holt, one of the Judges in the above named court, upon the petition of the plaintiff for absolute decree of divorce from the defendent Jimmie Vann, and for alimony which said petition alleges that the said defendent has been guilty of habitual drunkneness and extreme cruelty toward the plaintiff.
