not be destroyed or removed without the consent of the second party or its assigns; and the first party agrees to keep said premises unceasingly insured furing the life of this mortgage against fire, lightning, and tornado for mt less than twenty three hundred fifty and now collars, in form and companies satisfactory to second party or its assigns, and that all policies for such insurance and any insurance now or hereafter written couring said premises shall be immediately after the execution thereof delivered to the second party or its assigns, and all policies covering expired isurance shall be delivered to second party or its assigns at least thirty days before the expiration date of such expiring insurance, all of such policies to have mortgge clause of a form satisfactory to second party or its assigns attached. If the title to said premises be transferred, the second partyn or its assigns is authorized as agent for the first party, to assign the insurance to the grantee of the title, without any duty, however, on the second party or its assigns so to do.

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It is further understood and agred that in event any taxes or assessmets against said peemises become delinquent or any other sums become due, the payment of which is necessary to protect the property or the rights of the second party or its assigns, or in the event of the failure to procure and keep in force insurance as herein provided, the second party of its assigns may pay such taxes or assessments or sums necessary, or procure and pay such such insurance (but there is no obligation upon the second party or its assigns so to do); and the first party agrees to repay the same immediately withinterest at 10% which sums so expended and interest shall be a lien on the real property above described and secured hereby.

It is further agreed that if and as often as this mortgage or the notes secured hereby are placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, the first party agrees to pay to the holder hereof 10% of the amount ten secured hereby, which shall in no event be less than \$50.00 as a reasonable attorney's fee, which is hereby agreed to be a reasonable attorney's fee, and which shall be secured hereby and shall upon a foreclosure hereof be taxed as costs.

It is further agreed that any expense incurred in litigation or otherwise, or in the purchase of any abstract of title or continuation of any abstract of title which the holder hereof may at any time deem necessary, shall be paid by the first party to the holder hereof, which sum shall be a lien on the premises above described and secured hereby.

It is further agreed that in the event of the passage after the date of this mort - gage of any law of the State of Oklahoma, deducting from the value of land for the purposes of taxation any lien thereon or changing in any Way the laws now inforce for the taxation of mortgages, deeds of trustor the debts of obligations secured hereby for state or local purpose, or the manner of the collection of any such taxes so as to effect the interest of the holder of the whole of the principal sum secured by this mortgage, together with the interest due thereon, shall, at the option of the holder without notice to any party, become immediately due and payable.

It is further agreed that as additional collateral to secure the payment of the indebtedness secured hereby, first party hereby assigned to second party or its assigns all compensation or purchase money which may in any manner be received by the first party or the owner of the premises hereby mortgaged under agreement or by awards under eminent domain or taking said property for public use, and all profits, revenues, royalties, rents and benefits accruing to the first farst partyor the where of the property mortgage from said premises in any manner, including and under any and all oil, gas, mineral or other leases now on or hereafter placed thereon; this agreement to terminate
