# QUIT CLAIM DEED

Witnesseth: That said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of one and no/100 dollars, to him duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has quit claimed, granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do for sell heirs, executors and administrators, quit claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said parties of the second part and to their heirs and assigns, forever, all his right, title, interest, estate he may claim and demand both at law and equity in and to the following described property, to-wit:

addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according  
to the recorded plat thereof,

Together with all and singular hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging.

To have and to hold the above described premises unto the said John P. Barton and Della C. Barton, his wife, their heirs and assigns, so that neither E. J. Hutchison the said party of the first part, or any person in his name and behalf, shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the said premises or any part thereof; but they and everyone of them shall by these presents be excluded and forever barred.
