

Whereas, on the 3rd day of April, 1924, Maud Anderson, as lessor, made an executed a certain oil and gas lease unto M. M. Davis, and R. K. Welann, as lessees, upon the SE quarter of the NW quarter and the NE quarter of the SW quarter of section four, Twp. 18 north, and range thirteen east, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, said lease containing certain provisions for drilling, and operating said lease;

Now, therefore, for, and in consideration of the covenants and agreements contained in said lease, it is hereby agreed by the said Maud Anderson, lessor, that the drilling paragraphs shall be amended to read as follows: "Parties of the second part agree to drill at least three wells on the above described land; one of which wells shall be drilled deep enough to test what is known as the third break in the lime stone below the Wilcox sand, being the strata known as the Turkey Mountain, or the strata in which oil is found, in Turkey Mountain wells approximately 2700 feet deep, which deep test shall be drilled within six months from date of first production.

Unless one well is completed on said lands to the sand in which producing wells are found on adjoining land not later than the 5th day of August, 1924, then this lease shall terminate as to all parties, provided that if said first well should prove to be a dry or unprofitable hole, or by reason of accident or misfortune should be lost or should become impracticable to operate same, then second parties shall have a right to drill another well to the same sand within ninety days thereafter.

It is further agreed by said lessees, that the said Maud Anderson shall not be required to furnish any water pond for operations, but that said lessees shall furnish their own water pond or supply, at their cost.

In witness whereof, the parties hereto have made this agreement as an amendment to said lease contract on this the 10th day of May, 1924.
