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CONTRACT.

This agreement, made and entered into this ____ day of May, 1924, by and between Pawego Oil & Gas Company, a corporation, first party, and R. J. St. Germain, second party.

Witnesseth, that, whereas, heretofore and on the 11th day of February, 1924, said first party executed an oil and gas lease to said second party, covering the Northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section 30, township 19, north, range 12, east,

and which said lease was thereafter duly filed for record on May 22nd, 1924, in the office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma; and

Whereas, said lease contained the following provision;

"This lease shall be and become entirely null and void unless a Turkey Mountain Sand test well shall be commenced on or before three (3) months from this date within one half mile of some portion of the above described lands, and shall become null and void unless, within sixty (60) days after completion of such well, a Turkey Mountain Sand Test be spudded on the lands herein leased, and completed with due diligence.

Now therefore, the parties hereto, by mutual consent, hereby substitute the following provision in lieu of said provision above mentioned, to-wit:

This lease shall be and become null and void, unless within sixty days from this date, a Turkey Mountain sand test shall be spudded in on said northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section 30, township 19 north range 12 east, and the same shall be completed with due diligence unless oil or gas is found in paying quantities at a lesser depth, in which event said lessee, his heirs, successors or assigns shall have a further period of sixty days from and after the completion of said well, within which to commence the drilling of another well, on said premises, which said second well shall be completed to the Turkey Mountain sand with due diligence.

Except as above provided, the terms, conditions and provisions of said lease shall otherwise remain in full force and effect.
