FARM RENTAL CONTRACT.

Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the covenants, and agreements hereinafter made, the party of the first part has let, leased and demised, and does by these presents, let, lease and demise unto the party of the second part, for Agricultural purposes, for the term of one year from and after the first day of January, 1924, the following described tract of land lying in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma,

a ten acre tract in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ section 7/17/14

The said party of the second part, for the use of said land, agrees to pay to the party of the first part, as rent the sum of Grain Rent, - dollars- per annum during the term of this contract, payable as follows- one half of the cotton delivered to market at Bixby, Okla.

And the second party further agrees to tend the land in a farm like manner. and I agree to not allow no other man than G. J. Mulkey to stay on the premises. To give peaceable possession at the expiration of the contract now made.

And the said party of the first part agrees, to furnish one mule to tend the above land.
