

DECREE.

This matter came on to be heard before me, Edwin R. McNeill one of the Judges of the District Court in and for Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma this 12th day of June, 1924, upon the petition of Frederick Clarke Allender to have his name changed to Frederick Clarke Parnell, and it appearing to the court that due and legal notice of said petition has been given by publication for two consecutive weeks prior to the rendering of this decree, in a newspaper printed in said county and State, to-wit: The Sand Springs Leader, published at Sand Springs, in this County and State; and the court having heard evidence in open court, finds that petitioner is more than twenty one years of age; that he is ^{of} sound mind and fully competent to transact his own affairs; that the interests of said petitioner will be materially promoted by granting the prayer of said petition; and that Frederick Clarke Allender has been an actual resident of the State of Oklahoma for more than one year next proceeding the filing of said petition and is at present an actual resident in good faith of Tulsa County. The court further finds that petitioner is married; that his wife was formerly Emma Elizabeth Redfield; that the petitioner has no children, and that said wife agrees and consents to the change of name as prayed for in said petition.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the court, that the name of Frederick Clarke Allender be and the same is hereby changed to Frederick Clarke Parnell, and the said petitioner is hereby authorized to transact business and is empowered to use the said name as herein changed in all things and ways ~~previously~~ as though his name had always been Frederick Clarke Parnell.
