ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE.

Whereas, the following oil and gas mining leases were entered into, to-wit:

One dated September 20, 1912, executed by Edith M. Perryman, Cozetta M. Perryman, Rachel H. Perryman, to F. B. Dillard and William Blake, covering the following described property, to-wit: Northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of section 35, Rwp 18, R. 12, and the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section 35, twp. 18, R12, and the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Sec. 35, twp. 18, R. 12, , all in Tulsa, County, Oklahoma,

One dated September 27, 1913, executed by Lula A. Jordan, to F. B. Dillard, covering the following described property, to-wit:

~~South~~ Southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of section 35, twp. 18, range 12, Tulsa County, Oklahoma; and October 18, 1915, executed by Lula A. Jordan and W. M. Jordan, her husband to F. B. Dillard, covering the following described property, to-wit: Southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section 35, Twp. 18, range 12, Tulsa County, Oklahoma,

Whereas, said oil and gas mining lease, insofar as same covers the following described property, are now owned by the Liberty Oil Company, Incorporated, to-wit: The south half of the northeast quarter ~~and~~ the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter, section 35, township 18, range 12 east, Tulsa County, Oklahoma,

Know all men by these presents: That I, George R. Bassett, Trustee in Bankruptcy of the Liberty Oil Company, Incorporated, and by virtue of the ~~pro~~<sup>ers</sup> sale issued by the Court of Bankruptcy of Wichita, Kansas, with full authority in me vested and for and in consideration of the sum of ten thousand four hundred (\$10,400.00) dollars, do by these presents, grant, transfer, set over, sell and assign unto Jos. Davis, A. R. Appleman, & C. H. Lebow, Tulsa, Oklahoma, their heirs and assigns, said oil and gas mining leases, insofar as the same cover the south half of the northeast quarter, and the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of section 35, township 18, range 12, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

Further, I, George R. Bassett, Trustee in Bankruptcy of the Liberty Oil Company, Incorporated, as aforesaid, do hereby sell, transfer, set over, assign and deliver to said Jos. Davis, A. R. Appleman, & C. H. Lebow, all the oil and gas mining lease, fixtures, equipment, supplies, material casing, derricks, and all other personal property used in connection with or incidental to the operation of the oil and gas mining leases on the property herewith assigned and conveyed.

That this assignment shall take effect on the 30th day of April, 1924 to continue during all the rest, residue and remainder of said term, of said lease, subject, nevertheless, to the covenants conditions and provisions of said lease mentioned.

That I do hereby covenant, promise and agree that said assignment premises are now free and clear of all assignments, back rents, judgements liens or pledges made in the aforesaid lease by me whatsoever, except those that may hereafter arise from the conditions contained in the aforesaid lease.
