That whereas, on the 23rd day of March, A.D. 1923, in the District Court in and for Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, at the March 1923 term of said court, in a certain action therein pending, wherein The Continental National Bank, a corporation, was plaintiff, and P. E. Magee was one of the defendants, the said plaintiff, The Continental National Bank, by the consideration of the Court, recovered a judgement against the defendant, P. E.
