This deed being made to release the lien of a certain mortgage of - dated November 27th 1905 and recorded Nov 29th 200 PM 1905 in Record Book 176, of the records of the Western Recording District of the Indian Territory, of O. W. Shelton Clerk conveying said real estate to Ethel Davis to secure the payment of a certain note therein named, the same having been fully paid. Witness my hand this 19th day of October 1911.
