

Probate No. 187
Order of Confirmation

State of Oklahoma, No. 187 In the County Court
County of Tulsa, Order of Confirmation.
In the Matter of the estate, of Wilbur Emory Campbell
deceased.

It appearing to the Court at a hearing on this 6th
day of June 1908, that on the 23rd day of May 1908, Emily M.
Campbell, executrix, in the above entitled case, filed
her petition in this court praying for the confirmation
of the land herein described and

It further appearing to the Court
that on the said 23rd day of May 1908, the Court
made an order setting the 6th day of June 1908 for
the hearing of said petition and in said order
required the publication of a notice of said hearing
for a period of ten days previous to the said 6th
day of June 1908, and

It further appearing to the Court that under
the terms of the will of the above named decedent
the said will having been admitted to probate in
this court on the 10th day of December 1907, the
executrix Emily M. Campbell, the petitioner afore-
named was authorized and empowered to sell
and dispose of any and all of the real estate of said
decedent as to her seemed fit and proper and;

It further appearing to the court that in
accordance with said power and authority given
in said will, the said executrix Emily M. Campbell
sold to Mary E. Kennedy Lot Six (6) in Block One
(1) of the George Perryman addition to the city of
Tulsa Oklahoma for the sum of \$8000, and

It further appearing to the Court that
no special mode of sale was required by said will
of the said decedent, and that said sale was legally
made and fairly conducted that the sum paid was
more than 90% of the appraised value of said lot, and
that no greater sum than above specified could be obtained
and; it further appearing to the Court that the said
executrix, filed her return of said proceedings of
said sale on the said 23rd day of May 1908, as
stated herein and It further having been proved
