

Deed of Release.

Know all men by these presents, That the Union Trust Company (an Indian Territory Corporation) of Tulsa Oklahoma, for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars to it paid by William P. Hall, does hereby grant, sell, quitclaim and release unto the said William P. Hall forever, the Hall his wife and heirs their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in the Tulsa & Creek Counties Oklahoma, formerly Western District of the Indian of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The lot 4 of NW 1/4 of section fifteen (15) and lot 4 of NE 1/4 of section sixteen (16) all in township nineteen (19) north range seven (7) east, and lot four (4) in block one hundred seventy four (174) in the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain mortgage dated January 23rd, 1906 and recorded February 1st 1906 as 920.74 in book 12 at page 12 of the records of Mortgages at Muskogee, And to-wit: This deed of release is made by the undersigned

officer of the Union Trust Company in pursuance of the authority conferred upon him in Article VII of the Articles of said Company as follows:

"The Secretary shall have equal power with the President to satisfy and release mortgages, judgments or certificates of trust, its open contracts, releases or other instruments in the transaction of the company's business."
