Deed of Release.

Know all men by these presents,

That the Union Trust Company (an Indian Territory Corporation) of Tulsa, Oklahoma, for and in consideration of the sum of twenty-five hundred forty-two ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ dollars to it paid by William P. Hall, does hereby grant, sell, quitclaim and release unto the said William P. Hall & Anna C. Hall his wife and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in Creek & Tulsa Counties, Oklahoma, formerly Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of section fifteen (15), and SE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of section sixteen (16) and NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of section sixteen (16) all in Township nineteen (19) north, range seven (7) east, and lot four (4) in block one hundred seventy four (174) in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the official plat thereof. This deed being made to release the lien of a certain mortgage dated February 17th 1906, and recorded February 28th, 1906 at 9 a.m. in book "W" at page "130" of the records of mortgages at Sapulpa, Ind. Ter. This deed of release is made by the undersigned officer of the Union Trust Company in pursuance of the authority conferred upon him in Article VII of the by-laws of said company, as follows: "The Secretary shall have equal powers with the President to satisfy and release mortgages, judgments or certificates of trusts to execute contracts, releases or other instruments in the transaction of the Company's business."
