It is hereby understood and agreed by the parties hereto that if the Secretary of the Interior in any time satisfied that any of the covenants contained therein or that any of the provisions of any regulations heretofore or that may hereafter be lawfully prescribed by him, have been or are being violated, he may cancel this lease, and that his retention of cancellation shall be effective without resorting to the courts and without further proceedings, and that the lessor shall then be entitled to the immediate possession of the land.
