 Indian Office. It is expressly understood and agreed by
 the parties heret that if the Deciding of the Indian is at
 any time satisfied that any of the grounds contained herein
 or that any of the provisions of any regulations heretofore or
 that may hereafter be enacted, provided by him, have
 been or are being violated, he may cancel this lease, and
 that his declaration of nullification shall be operative
 without resorting to the said and without further
 proceedings, and that the lease shall be null and void
 the moment the provisions of the said Indian law herein have
 been violated, and that the said lease shall be null and void
 as to the hands and effects of the said lease and not
 as to the land covered by it.
