

Release of Mortgage.

Where acknowledged by deed, passed, March, 1889, between, on the 21st day of February A.D., 1905 a mortgage was executed by John Brown and James Brown to George Investment Company of New York, New York, for the consideration therein expressed, upon the following property, to-wit: The west half of the west half, quarter, and the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section thirty-four (34) Township seven (7) North Range thirteen East, fourth in the Creek Nation (Indian Territory, (13) east, situated in the Creek Nation (Indian Territory, said mortgage having been filed for record on the 5th day of March A.D., 1905 and recorded in Book M. at page 514, in the office of the County Clerk of the United States Court and of office records at Muskogee, Indian Territory, and which was given to secure the payment of a note for \$10,000 and interest, said instrument has been paid and satisfied in full. Now in consideration of the payment of said indebtedness in full and other considerations to the undersigned in hand paid by said John Brown and James Brown the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we have granted, released, quitclaimed and set over, and by these presents do hereby grant, release, quitclaim and set over unto the said John Brown and James Brown, their heirs and assigns, all our right, title and interest in and to said mortgage and property, together with all the restrictions and covenants and covenances thereto belonging to the intent that the property hereby conveyed may be discharged from said mortgage it have and it hold the land and premises hereby released and conveyed unto the said John Brown and James Brown their heirs and assigns, and to their heirs, next, single and double, forever, free, clear and discharged of and from all liens and claim made and by virtue of the mortgage aforesaid.
