

# Grazing Lease Cherokee Nation Oklahoma

Transferrable Only with consent of the Secretary of the Interior.

This indenture made and entered into, in quadruplicate, on this 25<sup>th</sup> day of August A.D. 1908 by and between Ma Salow Ne Pigeon Roll #26001 of Creek Town Okla party of the first part, and O. L. Brown of Tulsa Okla party of the second part, under and in accordance with the provisions of existing law and the rules and regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior relative to grazing leases in the Cherokee Nation Oklahoma.

Witnesseth: That said party of the first part, of and in consideration of the covenants of the said party of the second part, hereinafter set forth, do hereby lease presents lease to said party of the second part for grazing purposes only, the following described tract of land lying and being within the limits of the Cherokee Nation, and within the State of Oklahoma, to wit:

The SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of N 20 1/4, and the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 32 of Township 22 of Range 13 of the Indian Meridian and containing 50 acres, more or less, for the full term of Ten years from date hereof and the said party of the second part, in consideration of said premises, as above set forth, covenant and agree with the party of the first part to pay said party of the first part, as rental for the same the sum of One hundred & twenty five dollars, being at the rate of 25¢ per acre, payable as follows, to wit:

Twelve Dollars and fifty cents on the first day of January of each year for the term for which this lease is to run.

Said party of the second part covenant and agree that at the expiration of the time mentioned in this lease he will surrender to said party of the first part possession of the leased premises in good condition the wear and tear and unavoidable accident excepted and that failure, neglect or refusal to pay the
