This indenture made and entered into in Quasapahiche, on this third day of September A.D. 1908 by and between Grant Smoot of Pigeon part of the first party, and Ch Brown of Tulsa Okla part of the second party, under and in accordance with the provisions of existing law and the rules and regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior relative to grazing leases in the Cherokee Nation, Oklahoma.

Witnesseth: That said party of the first part for and in consideration of the covenants of the said party of the second party, hereinafter set forth, does by these presents lease to said party of the second part for grazing purposes only the following described tract of land lying and being within the limits of the Cherokee Nation and within the State of Oklahoma to wit:
