

Deed Of Dedication.

Know All Men By These Presents:

That whereas, under the terms of the last will and testament of Wilbur Emory Campbell, deceased, said will having been admitted to probate in the County Court in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma on the 10th day of December, 1907, and by said will Emily M. Campbell was appointed executrix of said will and power was given the said executrix to dispose of, in such manner as seemed to her fitting, any and all real estate decedent died seized of, and to sell and convey the same by good and sufficient instruments of conveyance; and

Whereas it appearing that the testin-
terests of the estate will be conserved by the dedication of a certain portion thereof to and for the use of the Public; and

Whereas on the 10th day of September, 1908, the executrix, acting under the authority given her by said will did dedicate to and for the use of the Public the following described lands to-wit:

The East Twenty-nine (29) feet of Block Four (4) of the D. D. Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof; and,

Whereas on the 10th day of September, 1908, the said executrix presented her petition to the probate court of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, praying that said dedication be in all things confirmed and ratified; and

Whereas the County Court, did on the 10th day of September, 1908, make certain order adjudging and decreeing that the said dedication be and is thereby valid in all things confirmed and ratified, and directing the said executrix to make a good and sufficient conveyance of said property to and for the use of the Public;
