

Deed of Release.

Know all men by these presents:

That Katherine J. Miller for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar, to me paid by Loren Conaway & Ada Conaway, her wife, at herby grant, sell, quitclaim and release unto the said Loren Conaway & Ada Conaway, his wife and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in the twenty eighth Recording District formerly within the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The south twenty-five feet of lot one, and the north half of lot two, in block one hundred seventy, in the City of Tulsa, Western District of Indian Territory, according to the U.S. Survey and plat thereof. This deed being to release the loan of a certain deed of mortgage dated August 1st, 1904 and recorded August 13th, 1904 in Book L at Page 298 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by Loren Conaway & Ada Conaway, her wife conveying said real estate to Katherine J. Miller to secure payment of one certain note therein named, the same having been fully paid.
