

Bonus of \$40⁰⁰ and a royalty of ten per cent, together with all costs and expenses of said leasing; that the said offer was made by the aforesaid Tulsa Transit Company, and was accepted by the Guardian.

It is therefore, ordered, and adjudged by the Court that the acts of the said Guardian in executing said lease be, and the same are hereby, approved, and the lease so made by him on the 7th day of October, A.D. 1907, on the above described land, of the said minor, to the Tulsa Transit Company, for a period of 5 years be, and the same is hereby in all respects confirmed and approved.
