

pursuant to said notice and that the highest bid offered him for an Oil and Gas lease on the said lands, provided for the payment to the said Guardian of a bonus of \$800 and a royalty of ten per cent together with all costs and expenses of said leasing; that the said offer was made by the ~~said~~ ^{present} Boulden Oil Company, and was accepted by the Guardian.

It is therefore ordered and adjudged by the Court that the acts of the said Guardian in executing said lease be, and the same are hereby, approved, and the lease so made by him on the 7th day of October, A.D. 1907, on the above described land, of the said Minor to the Boulden Oil Company, for a period of 8 years, and the same is hereby in all respects confirmed and approved.
