South West quarter of North West quarter of North East quarter; and North East of North West quarter of the North East quarter of Section Thirty-two (32) Township Twenty (20) North Range Thirteen (13) East

This deed is made to correct acknowledgment to deed dated June 5th, 1908, between the same parties.

To Have and To Hold said described premises unto the party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever.
