

All money falling due under the terms of the grant may be paid direct to the first party or to the credit of first party at the Central National Bank of Tulsa, Oklahoma. It is mutually agreed by and between the first and second parties hereto that in further consideration for the payment of said money One Dollar and all sums due hereunder to date of payment by second party, first party grants unto second party the right to release, and terminate this grant at any time. Therefore all liabilities of first party and second parties hereunder shall cease and determine.

Second party shall have the right to use sufficient gas oil and water to drill all wells and for all purposes on a continuous basis in operating the same. The terms and conditions of this grant shall extend to the heirs successors and assigns of the parties hereto.
