Release of Agricultural Lease.

Know all men by these presents: Whereas, on the
6th day of October, 1904, a certain agricultural lease was
executed by Sallie Cox, Lessor, to S. R. Lewis, Lessee, for the
sum of three hundred dollars, upon the following real
estate for a term of five years from date thereof, viz:

The North West quarter of the North West quarter,
and the South East quarter of the North West quarter, and the
North East quarter of the South West quarter of the North West
Quarter of Section Twenty three (23) Township twenty (20)
North, Range thirteen (13) east containing ninety (90) acres
more or less, which said agricultural lease is recorded
in Record Vol. 8 page 500 of Rogers County, Oklahoma,
formerly the 4th recording District of the Northern Judicial
District of the Indian Territory.

Whereas, the said S. R. Lewis, Lessee, in consideration of
Ninety (\$90) Dollars to him in hand paid by H. D. Rabold,
receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has accepted as full

heirs or assigns, forever.
