

Lease from a lease 1908 approved April 20, 1909

Oil and Gas Mining Lease in its hand selected for allotment. Charles H. Hester, Oklahoma, this in-
dustrial space made and entered into in practice-
policies on Rio 2nd day of July A.D. 1908, by and
between Wiley E. Chambers of Cherokee Okla, a
mixed blood citizen of the Cherokee Nation party of
the first part, hereinafter designated as lessor and
The Shaw Okmulgee Oil Company a corporation
of Texas. Oil, party of the second part hereinafter
designated as lessee, under and in pursuance
of the provisions of the act of Congress approved
July 1, 1908, 32 Stat. 7916 hereinafter.

1. The lessor for and in consideration
of one dollar, the receipt whereof is, acknowledged
and by the royalty covenants stipulations and conditions
hereinafter contained and hereby agreed to be paid should
and performed by the lessee, does hereby devise
grant lease and let unto the lessee for the
term of five years from the date of the approval
hereof by the Board of the Interior and as
much longer hereafter as oil or gas is found in
paying quantities as the oil deposits and
natural gas in or under the following described
tract of land lying and being within the
county of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
The S. 1/4 of the N. 2 E. 1/4 of the S. 21 T. 9 S. of the
N. 2 E. 1/4 of the S. 21 T. 9 S. of section 22, Township 22 S.
Range 13 E. of the Indian Meridian and
containing 80 acres more or less with the
exclusive right to prospect for, extract pipe
stone and measure oil and natural gas and to
occupy and use so much acre of the surface
of said land as may reasonably be necessary
to carry on the work of prospecting for
extracting, pumping, storing and measuring such
oil and natural gas, also, the right to obtain
from well or other sources on said land by
means of pipe lines or otherwise as sufficient supply
of water to carry on said operations and also the
right to use, free of cost oil and natural gas
