Deed of Release.

Know all men by these presents:

That P.M. Kerr for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) dollar to me in hand paid by George W. Adams, Charles Staley, Joseph Cooper and the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant sell, quit claim and release unto the said George W. Adams, Charles Staley, Joseph Cooper, and unto their heirs and assigns forever the following described real estate lying in Tulsa County Oklahoma Territory:

First: all that part of $56\frac{1}{4}$ of the $11\text{ or }14$ and the $11\frac{1}{2}$ of the $56\frac{1}{4}$ lying south of the main channel of the Arkansas river, in section 13, and $12\frac{3}{4}$ acres off of the east side of the $11\text{ or }14$ of the $56\frac{1}{4}$ lying south of the main channel of the Arkansas river in section 14 all in township 19, range 11 east;

said leases were signed by George W. Adams and Charles Staley, dated April 25th, 1906, filed for record May 4th, 1906.

Second: The $56\frac{1}{4}$ of section 13 Township 19 N. Range 11 east, signed by J. T. Cooper and wife, George W. Adams and wife and Charles Staley and wife. Dated May 1st, 1906. Filed for record May 4th, 1906.

This deed of release being made to release the lien of certain oil and gas leases dated and filed for record as above mentioned with the U.S. Deputy Recorder at Sapulpa in the western District of the Indian Territory conveying the mineral rights in said real estate to the said P.M.
