Order for the removal of restrictions.

Whereas, Muskegee Essie Sullivan, nee Bittle, an allottee of the Creek Nation, has made application for the removal of restrictions from the following described lands to wit:

Lot two (2), and the west nineteen and eighty-two hundredths (92/100) acres of lot one (1) and the west half (1/2) of the west half (1/2) of the northeast ten (10) acres of lot one (1), section ten (10) township seventeen (17) north, range thirteen (13) east of the Indian Base and meridian.

Now, therefore, I, under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1904 (Public No. 141), and the regulations prescribed thereunder, hereby remove the restriction from said above described land without condition concerning terms of sale and disposal of the proceeds, said removal of restriction to be effective thirty days from date hereof.
