Release of Mortgage.

Know all men by these presents,

Whereas, on the 25th day of September 1907, a certain mortgage deed was executed by Louise Curry, mortgagor, to the Union Trust Company, mortgagee, for the sum of Five Hundred Dollars, upon the following described property, viz:
