Order confirming sale of real estate
and approving deed.

Now on this 3rd day of October ad., 1908, the
petition of Daniel W. Turner coming on to be heard
praying for an order of court approving the
sale of all his right title and interest in and to
certain real estate described in said petition to
Amos W. Lord, and it appearing to the Court
upon satisfactory proof that the said Daniel W.
Turner was the husband of Susan Turner deceased, and
is one of the heirs at law of the said Susan Turner
deceased; and that the said Daniel W. Turner has
a right to sell all of his right title and interest
in and to said real estate described in said
petition under and by virtue of the provisions
of an act of Congress public No. 140, approved
Aug 27th 1908.

That the sum as agreed upon between the
said Daniel W. Turner and Amos W. Lord was fair and
reasonable and not disproportionate to the value of the
interest of the said Daniel W. Turner in and to said
real estate mentioned in said petition and herein-
after particularly described.

And said matter being submitted to the
Court and upon due examination and consideration
of said petition and after a full and complete
hearing upon the same the court finds that
the sale of all the right title and interest of said
Daniel W. Turner in and to the lands of the said
Susan Turner deceased to Amos W. Lord, said sale
having been completed by delivery of deed by the
said Daniel W. Turner to the said Amos W. Lord
on the 27th day of July 1908 covering the following
described lands same being the allotment of
Susan Turner deceased in Tulsa County, State
