Assignment

In consideration of the sum of Ten (10) Dollars and other valuable considerations, we, Thomas J. Dawson and H.C. Walkley of Tulsa, Oklahoma, hereby assign to W. Braden of Pittsburg, Kas, all our right, title, and interest, in and to the following described property: The north half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) of the northwest (NW) quarter of the southeast (SE) quarter (4) and the southeast (SE) quarter (4) of the northwest (NW) quarter (4) of the southeast (SE) quarter (4) of section thirty-five (35), and north half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) of the northwest (NW) quarter (4) of the northwest (NW) quarter (4) and the southeast (SE) quarter (4) of the northwest (NW) quarter (4) of the northwest (NW) quarter (4) of section thirty-three (33) and the south half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) of the northwest (NW) of the northwest quarter (NW) of section twenty-one (21) all in Township twenty (20) north, range thirteen (13) east.

Said rights being obtained by certain oil and gas mining lease dated October 10th, 1905, filed in the proper office of record in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, October 10th, 1905, executed by John Woodard, as grantor, to T. J. Dawson as grantee; also by another dated October 10th, 1905, filed in the proper office of record in Tulsa County, Oklahoma on the 12th day of October, 1905, executed by John Woodard as grantor, to Thomas J.
