Order of Court confirming sale of real estate.

An order of this court having been made by this court on the 30th day of September, 1908 authorizing James G. Wilson, as the Guardian of Felix Wilson, James W. Wilson and Henry Wilson, minors, to sell certain real estate belonging to said minors, and afterwards, to-wit: on the 28th day of October, 1908, the said James G. Wilson, having made to this court and filed in the office thereof a return of his proceedings under the said order of sale, and duly returned to this court an account of sales, verified by affidavit of said James G. Wilson, this court having examined the said return and having in open court also examined the said James G. Wilson, and it appearing to the satisfaction of this court,

* That in pursuance of said order of sale, James G.
