

using sufficient water from the premises to run all necessary machinery and at any time to remove all machinery and fixtures placed on said premises; and further upon the payment of One dollar at any time after the giving three months notice by the party of the second part, its successors or assigns to the parties of the first part his heirs or assigns said party of the second part its successors or assigns shall have the right to surrender this grant for cancellation after which all payments and liabilities thereafter to accrue under and by virtue of its term shall cease and determine and this grant become absolutely null and void.
