

Assignment of Mortgage

Whereas, on the 16th day of August, 1907, James P. Cantrill, a single man, made, executed and delivered one certain real estate mortgage to J. H. Hammond, on the following described and stated land:

Ward, Secretary to the Commissioner of the Land Office of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over unto the Mutual Trust Corporation, a corporation of Tulsa, Oklahoma, the said note and mortgage above described.
