

Assignment of Oil Lease.

Know all Men By These Presents That Whereas on the 27th day of August, 1907, Nathaniel D. Smith and Lucy Ann Smith, co-parties of the first part, made and entered into a certain oil lease with The Duguegne Oil and Gas Company, of the second part and

Whereas under the rules adopted by said Commissioners of the Land Office before also can be made upon land which is encumbered by an oil and mineral lease or either it is required that the applicant cause an assignment of all his right, title, and interest in and to the lease including all sums or annuities payable as royalty, interest, or earnings to be made to the State of Oklahoma.
