Order confirming sale of real estate.

An order having been made by this court on the 3rd day of April A.D. 1908 authorizing Albert P. Terrill, as guardian of the persons and estates of May S. Terrill, et al. minors, to sell certain real estate belonging to the said minors, May S. Terrill, Edward W. Terrill, Rosa P. Terrill and Frank L. Terrill and of the same tract on the 20th day of May A.D. 1908 the said Albert P. Terrill having made to the court and filed in the office thereof, a return of his proceedings under the said order of sale and duly returned to this court an account of sales verified by affidavit of said Albert P. Terrill, this court having examined the said return and having in open court also examined the said Albert P. Terrill and it appearing to the satisfaction of this court that in pursuance of said order of sale, Albert P. Terrill caused a notice of the time and place of holding said sale to be posted up in three of the most public places in said County, in which the land ordered to be sold is situated, and to be published in the Oklahoma State a newspaper printed and published in the said County where said land is situated and also caused to be printed in the Oklahoma Times a newspaper printed and published in Rogers County, Oklahoma, said notice for three consecutive weeks before such sale, in which notice the land and tenements to be sold were described with common certainty that at the time and place of holding such sale specified in said notice, the said Albert P. Terrill caused to be sold the entire tract of land or estate in the said lands owned by said
