

Assignment of Gas and Gas Mining Lease.

These indenture made on the 17th day of December, 1904, by and between The Dinwo Oil Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, plaintiff of the first part, and The Gas Oil Company, a corporation, organized under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, party of the second part, witnesseth:

That for a valuable consideration paid the first party to the second party, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the party of the first part has hereby granted, sold, assigned, transferred and conveyed and by these presents doth hereby grant, sell, assign, transfer and convey to the second party, its successors and assigns all of the first party's right title, claim interest and estate in and to a certain oil and gas mining lease located on the 5th day of September, 1905, by Julia Johnston, Guardian of the Estate of John Johnston, the north West quarter of section eight (8), Township twenty one (21), north range thirteen (13), east of the Indian Meridian in Tulsa County State of Oklahoma and containing eighty (80) acres more or less and which said certain oil and gas mining lease is further described as having been filed for record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, on the 22 day of October, 1905 and being recorded in Book 2, at page 2, in the office of said Register of Deeds.

To Have and to hold, unto the said party of the second part its successors and assigns extending to the terms and conditions of said original lease.
