

Agreement

an agreement made and entered into this 21st day of December AD 1888 by and between William Ward and Belle Ward his wife parties of the first part and C. Halrell party of the second part witnesses:

That the parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred Dollars \$700⁰⁰ to be paid by party of the second part as hereinafter provided have this day sold to party of the second part upon the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth, the following described real estate to wit:

The South half S³ of the Southwest quarter 39th of Section thirty-three 33, Township twenty-one 21, north range thirteen 13 east of the Indian Base and meridian

It is understood and agreed by and between the parties hereto, that the parties hereto of the first part do not at this time have legal title to the land above described and that the same land has heretofore been filed upon by one Nattie Webber as legal lot and that contest is now pending before the Dawes Commission between said William Ward and said Nattie Webber respecting the right to file on said land as an allotment.

It is further understood and agreed by and between the parties hereto that the parties of the first part do not at this time have legal title to the land above described and that the same land has heretofore been filed upon by one Nattie Webber as her allotment that contest
